## Our Commitment

Compliyant is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities. Accessibility is not treated as a one-time compliance activity. It is a continuous, organization-wide discipline embedded into how we design, build, and maintain our digital experiences.

We strive to ensure that all users, regardless of ability, can perceive, navigate, understand, and interact with our content effectively. This commitment reflects both our professional standards as an accessibility consulting firm and our responsibility to lead by example.

## Accessibility Standards

The Compliant website is designed and maintained to conform with:

- Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 Level AA

WCAG 2.2 is the current international standard for digital accessibility and defines testable success criteria across four principles: Perceivable, Operable, Understandable, and Robust.

These guidelines address a broad range of disabilities, including visual, auditory, physical, cognitive, and neurological conditions.

## How We Achieve Accessibility

### 1. Accessibility by Design

Accessibility is integrated from the earliest stages of design and content creation. It is not retrofitted after development.

- Semantic HTML and ARIA used appropriately
- Color contrast validated against WCAG thresholds
- Focus order and keyboard navigation intentionally designed
- Content structured for assistive technologies

### 2. Multi-Layer Testing Approach

We do not rely on automated tools.

Our evaluation model includes:

- Automated testing for baseline issue detection
- Manual expert review aligned to WCAG success criteria
- Assistive technology testing such as screen readers and keyboard-only navigation
- Scenario-based validation reflecting real user journeys

### 3. Ongoing Monitoring and Continuous Improvement

Accessibility is actively maintained. It is not assumed.

We:

- Conduct periodic re-evaluations
- Track and remediate issues as they arise
- Update content and components as standards evolve
- Align with new WCAG success criteria as they are introduced

Accessibility is treated as a living system, not a static deliverable.

### Known Limitations

We aim for full conformance, but accessibility is an evolving process.

Some areas of the website may not yet fully conform to WCAG 2.2 AA due to:

- Platform constraints associated with Wix
- Third-party integrations outside of our direct control
- Legacy or rapidly updated content

Where limitations exist, we work to provide accessible alternatives whenever possible.
